


# Leaving A Legacy In Your Will To The Wigmore Hall Trust Registered Charity No. 1024838



## What do I say in my Will if I want to leave the Wigmore Hall Trust a legacy?

If you are kindly considering leaving us a gift then the wording below can be used in your Will. However, we always recommend that you take professional advice to ensure the legacy meets your own personal circumstances. Your solicitor can advise you to make sure that your intentions are expressed in correct legal terms.

Here is some suggested wording which you might find helpful:

- **Residuary bequest**

This is the gift of whatever is left (the residue) after specific gifts to family and friends, expenses, debts or liabilities have been paid.

*I give all (or a ....% share of) the residue of my estate to the **Wigmore Hall Trust Charity No. 1024838** to be used for its general charitable purposes and I declare that the receipt of their Treasurer or other proper officer shall be a full and sufficient discharge.*

- **Pecuniary bequest**

This is a gift of a fixed amount of money and the exact figure must be stated.

*I give free of tax to the **Wigmore Hall Trust Registered Charity No. 1024838** the sum of £ [words and figures] to be used for its general charitable purposes, and I declare that the receipt of their Treasurer or other proper officer shall be a full and sufficient discharge.*

## Changing your Will – Suggested Codicil Wording

You can make changes to your Will by adding a codicil. This is not recommended in the case of a major alteration in which case it is advisable to write a new Will. Should you wish to add a bequest to Wigmore Hall to an existing Will, the following wording is suggested.


